[post\_tags] At the other end of the pay spectrum, Chris Jarvis, an intern at Sony, successfully negotiated a £4,600 settlement for unpaid wages during his three month internship. Mr Jarvis said that instead of shadowing a Sony employee, he

was working as a tester for the games department and therefore was entitled to minimum wage.. Sony unsuccessfully asked Mr Jarvis to sign a gagging order. For all employers out there, voluntary workers can only be employed AND unpaid by a charity, a voluntary organisation, a fund raising body or a statutory body.
